

◆How to enjoy the public bath ◆

◇Business Hours◇

- Our business is open 11:00–24:00 Wednesday–Monday. Closed on Tuesday.

◇Entrance◇

- Please take off your shoes and put them in the shoe locker at the entrance.

◇Reception /Check-in ◇

- If you will come by car, please park in the vacant space and leave your car key at the front desk.
- Valuables and luggage which will not fit in the lockers can be kept at the front desk.
- An explanation of how to use the bath is posted at the front so that first-time visitors can more easily understand how to enjoy the sento.

- There is no time limit for using the bath during regular business hours.

◇Payment Method◇

- Payment can be made at reception or by purchasing a ticket from the ticket vending machine.
- Payment can be made with cash or electronic money.
- The bathing charge is 460 yen. (for visitors over 12 years old who do not use the sauna)
- The charge for those entering the sauna will be 730 yen (460yen+270yen)
- .Bath and wash towels are included.
- All-inclusive set will be 800 yen (includes sauna access, bath and wash towels, soap, shampoo, and conditioner).
- What is sauna?

High temperature sauna, it's about 90°C. Infrared heaters emit radiant heat which opens the pores and helps rinse the body of waste products through sweat. It is also said to increase the body's ability to recover from fatigue and self-heal ailments such as a stiff neck and back pain.

- Bathhouse Entrance Fee

Adults [over 12 years old] : 460 yen

Children [6 years old to 12 years old]: 180 yen

Young Children [less than 6 years of age]: 80 yen (up to two young children can enter for free with an adult).

- About children in the bath

There is a regulation that boys and girls older than 10-years-old cannot share the same bathroom. Age limits will vary depending on the prefecture - if you plan to travel outside Tokyo, please check with the bathhouse where you are going.

- Toiletries

We sell towels for bathing, shampoo, soap, and other goods such as disposable razors. There is no free shampoo or body soap inside.

Soap - 20 yen Shampoo - 30 yen , Hair Rinse - 30 yen · Rental Towels, disposable razors 30 yen: Wash towels - 50yen . Bath towels -100 yen

※ Rental towels are safe and ready to use, each towel is cleaned and disinfected by a reliable laundry service.

- Please wear a wristband when entering the sauna.
- The sauna wristband indicates that the fee for sauna entry has been paid.
- Please bring your locker key with you.

We will only keep the shoes locker key for those using the sauna.

- Please return rental towels back to the front desk.
- Hair dryer costs 20 yen for 3 minutes of use.
- Coin massage will be 100 yen for 15 minutes.

◇Dressing room and Bathroom◇

- You will first enter into the dressing room, where lockers are available.
- You can use any available locker. Please choose whichever one you' d like.
- The locker will return your 100 yen coin when you are done.
- The toilets are located at the dressing room on this floor as well as the upper floor.

◇About the floor◇

• There is a coin laundry and parking lot on the 1st floor. The 2nd floor has the front lobby, a dressing room, and bathing facilities. There is a banquet hall, rest area, and a massage room on the 3rd floor.

• The bathroom has showers, bathtubs, and an outdoor black water hot spring which can be accessed through a door at the back of the bathroom.

• You can buy meals and drinks at the lounge and rest area by using the ticket vending machines.

- Free Wi-Fi is available at the lounge and rest area on the 3rd Floor.

◇Water Quality Control ◇

• Every day after the end of business hours, all of the water in the bathtub is drained and replaced. Water quality control is always kept in mind so that you can take a bath safely and comfortably.

◇Prohibited Matter◇

• Towels can be brought into the bathroom, but for sanitation reasons, putting them in the bathtub is prohibited.

• Breakable or slippery substances such as glass items and body oils cannot be brought into the bathroom as it is very dangerous.

• Smartphones and mobile phones with a camera cannot be used in the dressing room or bathroom. Please use them in the lobby or the lounge.

◇Notes◇

• Please keep valuables, shoe locker keys, and locker keys secure so you do not lose them. This shop will not bear responsibility in the case of trouble. Also, a key exchange fee will be applied in the case of a lost locker key.

• Please be aware that the outdoor bath has an open ceiling, so loud conversations may be troublesome for neighboring residents.

• Please refrain from occupying this space with your personal belongings.

• Please wash your body and rinse off prior to entering the bathtub. After you enter the outdoor black water hot spring, please wash your body again prior to entering the sauna or other bathtubs.
